<b>I. General area</b>		
1	Is the site within reasonable distance (1 hour by bus) from an international airport?	
2	Is the site within a reasonable distance (5-10 km) from a habitable area?	
3	Is the access to the site easy, by asphalt roads?	
4	Are there any signs showing the entrance of the site to the public?	
5	Are there suitable hotels in the area for the officials and the skiers?	
6	Were there enough beds for all the people involved at the competition?	
7	Is there any organised camping near the competition site?	

<b>II. Sites area</b>		
1	Were there enough access roads round the competition site?	
2	Does the site have a parking area?	
3	Is the surrounding area clean and attractive?	
4	Are there any problems like heat, dust, cold, insects, or pollution?	

<b>III. Water area</b>		
1	Does the lake have enough length for the approach of the boat in the slalom and the jump course?	
2	Does the lake have adequate bright for the safe positioning of the courses?	
3	Does the site have adequate protection from winds, from all the directions?	
4	Is the site safe for the competitors?	
5	Is there any backwash after the passage of the boat?	
6	Is the water depth steady for a period of a week?	
7	Is the water clean and suitable for swimming and water-skiing?	
8	Does the water have any plants or other objects that can cause problems for the speedometers?	
9	Does the water have enough depth, for safe water-skiing?	

<b>IV. Spectators area</b>		
1	Do the spectators have a good view of the competition site?	
2	Do the spectators have seats or benches on which to sit?	
3	Is there any shade for the spectators (trees, tent, etc.)	
4	Does the site have a public address system to provide information to the spectators?	
5	Are there any restaurant or similar facilities for the public?	
6	Are there any public telephones?	
7	Are there toilets for the spectators?	
8	Are there any waste baskets for the spectators?	
9	Does a First aid station exist?	
10	Is the parking area large enough for the spectators?	

<b>V. Competition constructions</b>		
1	Is the Judges tower safe, functional and near the waters edge?	
2	Does the Judges tower provide a satisfactory view to the tricks course?	
3	Are the Judges towers for slalom functional, with an easy access?	
4	Does the position of the starting docks offer a satisfactory distance to the entrance of the competition courses?	
5	Are the starting docks large enough and with a smooth surface?	
6	Is there adequate space for the competition secretariat?	
7	Does the Secretariat area have a results board ?	
8	Do the organisers provide sufficient radios for contact between judges, starting dock and the competitions boats?	

<b>VI. Skiers area</b>		
1	Do the organisers provide an area only for the competitors?	
2	Do the competitors have dressing rooms?	
3	Do the competitors have specific safe space to leave their equipment?	
4	Are there any restaurant or similar facilities for the competitors?	
5	Do the competitors have access to drinking water facilities?	
6	Are there toilets for the competitors?	

<b>VII. Organisation</b>		
1	Did the organising committee meet all the needs of the competition?	
2	Were the organising committee people on place and on time?	
3	Were the organising committee people willing to help and solve any problems that might arise ? (attitude)	
4	Were the rescue teams trained and with the right equipment?	
5	Did the competition have any promotion to the media?	
6	Did the Press have adequate space and equipment (telephone, fax etc)?
