NOTE 2 : Medals.

NOTE 3 : Late Entry Fees.

= Late Entry Fee for all divisions = 10 EUR per day.

= The split is 50 % to the EC (Council) - 50 % to the organisers.

NOTE 4 : To Council.

= To assist officials travel.

= Income is paid to the relevant Council.

NOTE 5 : IWWF Licence.

= As for Wakeboard Cable the EMS roll-out has been postponed to 2023 the way to collect the riders IWWF licence fee is through all confederation and world championships.
